Organisation income less than £500,000.

Small grants - £85,500. Grants from £1,000 to £6,000.

Medium grants - £57,000. Grants from £6,000 to £15,000.

Deadline for applications 8am, 1st March Grants Panel 17 March.

 Supporting physical and mental health and wellbeing.

Tackling poverty.

Eligible Organisations

For

- ✓ not-for-profit organisations
- ✓in existence for more than 12 months
- √income of less than £500,000
- **✓** supporting Barnet residents
- ✓ complete projects by December 2021.

Eligibility

- Registered with Charity Commission, Companies House.
- Constituted Organisation with required governance.
- Constitution/Governing Document.

- Accounts or Income and Expenditure Records.
- Bank account with two signatories.

Project

Project Details

- What you will do (your activities)?
- Who are the people or community that need help?
- How often will the activities will take place (daily, weekly or monthly etc)?
- Which staff or volunteers will be involved?

These activities are also your 'outputs'.

People

The people your project will help.

What problems do they face? How have they been affected by Covid? How long has this been happening? What have they said is needed? What difference and changes will the project make?

These benefits or changes are also your 'outcomes.'

Inclusive

Your project open to and include people.

- Projects for people of particular community
- For example, Black or Asian people, young or older people, disabled people or children or older people.

 How will you make sure you reach people and are welcoming?

Budget

Staff costs: salaries

Volunteer expenses: data costs, travel

Activity or Project costs: publicity, venue hire, refreshments, insurance, translation, access

Equipment: small items of equipment.

Contribution to core costs: usually 10%
